

UPDATES: Cozumel map

Ferry:

- Price for the **passenger ferry** from Playa del Carmen to Cozumel has increased to 156 pesos each way (about \$12.50us).

Closings:

- **Jeannie's Waffle House** (#E24) has closed.
- **El Galeon** beach club (C64) on the east side of the has closed. It has been replaced by Andelle beach club (didn't have a great experience here).
- **El Bistro** (K34) has closed. It is replaced by La Lobsteria.
- **Le Chef** (K29) has closed. It is now named Olive.

New beach club:

- **Mike's Beach Club** is located north of Melia Cozumel (A2) before you get to the Country Club Estates area (A1). Menu and photos at www.mikesbarcozumel.com

New restaurants and/or locations:

- **Del Sur** is a new restaurant located at the corner of 5th avenue and calle 3 south (one block inland from the ocean, and two blocks south of the square). We've heard great reviews.
- **Woody's** bar and grill is located inland from the ferry dock, near the square (next to the 7-Eleven, #I39). It looks like a fun little bar/restaurant.
- **La Lobsteria** is now located at K34. Excellent seafood.
- **Olive** is now open at K29.
- **Torro's Place** is a party bar/restaurant located on the second-level on the oceanfront at the corner with calle 5 south. We've been reading that it is popular with cruise ship passengers.
- **Alberto's** is at the front of the Costa Brava hotel, #A55. Same owner as the beach club at #C52.

A change in policy:

- **Wet Wendy's** is a fun restaurant/bar; we noted on the map that they added an 18% tip. Well, that was something they were experimenting with because some customers weren't tipping. We are glad to hear they discontinued that experiment and we've X'd our comments out on the map.

New attraction:

- **Temazcal Cozumel** (www.temazcalcozumel) is a Mayan Steam Lodge located in the jungle south of the cruise ship docks.

Prices:

We recently made a quick, one-day, update trip along the east coast of Cozumel, and we were surprised to see that prices had increased an average of about 10 to 20 percent. Please don't be surprised if prices on the map are less than those on an actual menu. This is something we always have to deal with, and it may be better not to put actual prices on our maps, but we feel that it does give you some idea of what to expect.
